Deposit Policy, Checking In & Checking Out

Deposits & Balance Due

- Deposit Refund Refund requests will be honored if a cancellation notice is received 60 days prior to the reservation date. Any subsequent changes to the original reservation date does not affect when the original 60 day period expires. If a cancellation occurs after the 60 day notice period, the deposit will be forfeited. A \$25 fee will be assessed on all cancellations
- **Balance Due** Due upon check-in. Includes balance due after deposit, any applicable pet fees, and State of Montana Hospitality Tax. Please notify us prior to arrival if your party will pay separately. (Guests are responsible for the full length of their reservations no refunds for early departure.)

Check-In/Check-Out

- Check-in Time 3:00 pm on day of arrival.
- Check-out Time 11:00 am on day of departure. A late check-out may be allowed if scheduling permits. Please let us know <u>in advance</u> if you need this courtesy extended to you.

Electronic Services

Telephone Service, Internet and Television

- **Telephone Service** The lodges and cabins do not have telephones. A guest phone is usually available on the office door, number 406.682.3655.
 - A message service is provided for guests. Please inform family and friends that the resort contact number for messages and emergencies during the day is 406.682.4982, or call or text 406.210.8288, day and night.
 - There is limited cell phone service at Wilderness Edge. Service can be accessed a short distance away so please let us know if you need assistance.
 - Internet phone calls (e.g. Skype) do function well,
 WiFi calling generally works as well.
 - Internet Wilderness Edge provides internet access throughout the property with a strong and reliable wireless signal. However, our bandwidth is limited so we do ask our guests to refrain from on-line activities such as streaming so other guests can utilize this service.
 - **Television** With one exception, cabins and lodges do not have access to TV.

Emergency Services

We do have a defibrillator fitted for Adults and Children, we also have a Choking Rescue Device, both located in the Main Office.

Watercraft Rental Policies and Procedure

- All guests must check in with a member of the Wilderness Edge staff prior to using a boat, paddleboard or kayak.
- A basic "rules for renting and operating rental watercraft at Wilderness Edge" outline will be provided to each guest that wants to rent watercraft. Please review the contents before your planned departure to the lake.
- A signed "Release of Liability" form is required from each adult prior to using watercraft. (Signer must be 18 or over).
- Guests will be issued one life jacket for each person. Montana law stipulates that life jackets must be either worn or be on-board for all occupants of motorized boats. Boaters 12 or under must wear their life jackets at all times.
- Please remove trash from boats and return all life jackets to the boathouse when finished for the day. <u>Do not leave them in the boat or on the dock.</u>
- Motorized boaters must comply with vessel occupancy limits as stated on a visible tag in each motorboat (number of boaters or total weight).
- Watercraft rentals are to be used on Cliff Lake only.



Basic Advice & Other Information

- Food & Supplies Shop for groceries and supplies before you get to the resort. The closest full-service grocery and hardware stores are in West Yellowstone. However, if you are traveling through Bozeman, Idaho Falls or Jackson we suggest that you take advantage of retailers in these markets for better pricing and selection. Salt and pepper are the only food items provided in the lodges and cabins.
- Non-Smoking Facility All cabins and lodges at Wilderness Edge have been designated as **Non-Smoking**.
- *Speed Limit A* 7 mph speed limit goes into effect upon entering the resort, driving between cabins and lodges, and traveling the Forest Service road to Cliff Lake.
- Off-Road Motorized Vehicles (ATV's/UTV's/Dirt Bikes) Recreational use of ATVs, UTVs, and dirt bikes is not permitted on Wilderness Edge property. They are also not allowed on adjacent private land or Forest Service land.
- Excessive Noise The comfort and privacy of all our guests is important. Therefore, we request that guests refrain from loud conversation and/or party noise, especially after 10:00 pm. Amplified music is not allowed at any time.
- Campfires Except for the Saddlehorn Lodge, there are no individual fire rings at any other lodge or cabin. A common fire ring for all to share is located at the South end of the volleyball court. Management may restrict campfires if windy conditions dictate. In addition, local, state and/or federal fire restrictions will be enforced.
- *Firearms* Discharge of firearms, including pellet guns and Airsoft® replicas, is strictly prohibited on Wilderness Edge property, on the Forest Service road to Cliff Lake and the area surrounding the boat docks.
- Fishing A Montana resident or non-resident fishing license is required. Children under 12 may fish without a license, as long as there is a licensed adult present. Non-resident fishing licenses can be purchased on-line at the State of Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks website (www.fwp.state.mt.us).
 - Cliff Lake has a 5 fish limit, and anglers are encouraged to keep only what will be consumed during their stay.
 - Fish, Wildlife & Parks regulations prohibit disposing of fish entrails in streams or along lake shores. However, it is legal to dispose of entrails in lakes away from the shore. Please do not clean fish in Horn Creek or in kitchen/bathhouse facilities.
- Fly Fishing Guides Please check the links page on our website for a list of recommended guide services, or talk to our staff if you need assistance in securing a guided trip.
- On-Premise Amenities Wilderness Edge has available a volleyball area, basketball ½ court, horseshoe pits and a large campfire area for evening fellowship. Also, a free "library" of various board games and puzzles can be checked out at the Main Office.

From Bozeman, MT: Drive time from intersection of Hwy 191 and Hwy 84 - approx. 2 hours

- Take Highway 84 West to Norris
- Turn left in Norris on Highway 287 South to Ennis
- In Ennis, turn left at the stop sign junction (fisherman statue on left) and continue on Highway 287 South

 Note: There will be a Fishing Access sign at mile marker 12, then a sign that says Cliff and Wade Lakes. Drive past this turn-off (your GPS may instruct you to turn ignore this command, it will recalculate to the preferred route)
- 1/3 of a mile south of mile marker 9 turn right on Highway 87 (headed toward Ashton, ID)
- Look for Wilderness Edge sign on your right between mile markers 3 & 2
- Turn right on Horn Creek Road and follow it 4 miles to Wilderness Edge

From Idaho Falls, ID: Drive time from intersection of I-15 and Hwy 20 N - approx. 2 hours

- Take Highway 20 north through the Island Park area to the Highway 87 junction (.2 miles past mile marker 402)
- Turn left on Highway 87
- Travel approximately 11 miles and cross the Idaho/Montana border
- Look for Wilderness Edge sign on your left between mile markers 2 & 3 on the Montana side of the border
- Turn left on Horn Creek Road and follow for 4 miles to Wilderness Edge

From Jackson Hole, WY: Drive time via Hwy 22 over Targhee Pass – approx. 2 hours

- From Jackson, take Highway 22 West to Victor, Idaho
- Turn right on Highway 33
- Continue on Highway 33, then take Highway 32 just past Tetonia
- Continue on Highway 32 to Ashton
- Turn right in Ashton at the Highway 20 junction
- Continue north through the Island Park area to the Highway 87 junction (.2 miles past mile marker 402)
- Turn left on Highway 87
- Travel approximately 11 miles and cross the Idaho/Montana border
- Look for Wilderness Edge sign on your left between mile markers 2 & 3 on the Montana side of the border
- Turn left on Horn Creek Road and follow for 4 miles to Wilderness Edge

 Note: You may choose to take the route through Grand Teton/Yellowstone Park. This is the shortest route, but not necessarily the fastest depending on traffic in the park and your own individual desire to see various Park attractions.

 If you do take this route, follow the directions listed "From West Yellowstone, MT" when you reach this location.

From West Yellowstone, MT: Drive time from Park exit - approx. 35 minutes

- Take Highway 20 West towards Targhee Pass and Idaho
- Just west of mile marker 403 turn right on Highway 87
- Travel approximately 11 miles and cross the Idaho/Montana border
- Look for Wilderness Edge sign on your left between mile markers 2 & 3 on the Montana side of the border
- Turn left on Horn Creek Road and follow for 4 miles to Wilderness Edge

From Missoula, MT: Drive time from Orange St exit - approx. 3 ½ hours

- Take I-90 East towards Butte
- Continue on I-90 East through Butte to the Cardwell exit #256 (7 miles east of Whitehall)
- Take Montana Highway 359 to the Highway 287 Junction
- Turn right on Highway 287 South, go through Harrison and Norris to Ennis
- In Ennis, turn left at the stop sign junction (fisherman statue on left) and continue on Highway 287 South

 Note: There will be a Fishing Access sign at mile marker 12, then a sign that says Cliff and Wade Lakes. Drive past this turn-off (your GPS may instruct you to turn ignore this command, it will recalculate to the preferred route)
- 1/3 of a mile south of mile marker 9 turn right on Highway 87 (headed toward Ashton, ID)
- Look for Wilderness Edge sign on your right between mile markers 3 & 2
- Turn right on Horn Creek Road and follow for 4 miles to Wilderness Edge

GPS Coordinates

Many guests use a GPS device to help navigate their way to Wilderness Edge.
